Mobile phones in school

Please can we remind parents that children should only have mobile telephones in school if they are walking on their own to or from school.

Mobiles should be handed into the school office when the child arrives at school and can be collected at the end of the school day. If a child is walking home on their own after the end of the day, then they should also sign out so that we know that they have left the school building.

We will be checking regularly that mobile telephones have been handed in. Frequent offences may result in mobiles being banned from school.

Please can we ask that you do not allow your child to bring any other electrical devices into school.

The school holds no responsibility for the safety of these items on our premises but more importantly, we want to ensure that mobile telephones and electronic devices are being used safely and avoid leaving your child vulnerable.

Walking to and from school
