If your child is currently in year 2 and moving up to year 3, please be aware that – from September – you will need to pay for any school dinners that are ordered. Lunches cost £2.25 per day. You can pay online via School Gateway or by cheque (payable to Bristol City Council) or cash (please mark the envelope with your child's name and the amount you are paying).

If you are in receipt of certain benefits, your child may be eligible for free school meals. If they are, we are also able to receive Pupil Premium funding which is worth £1,300 per pupil to the school each year.

### Music lessons 2017-18 - NEW PUPILS WANTED (Years 2-6)

We have five spaces available for brass lessons and six spaces available for violin lessons starting in September for pupils from year 2 to year 6.

Fresh fruit and vegetables, pittas, dips and bread sticks are served daily and children are encouraged to take part in a variety of cooking and craft activities on offer throughout the day.
