Dear parents and carers,

You will be aware from my letter dated Wednesday 29<sup>th</sup> September that we have seen a small increase in the number of COVID cases within school. Following this letter being sent, Public Health England have advised that I implement some advanced control measures. This includes asking parents of pupils, whom the school identify as close contacts of a positive case, to arrange a PCR test for their child. If your child is identified as a close contact, we will inform you via phone call (or email if we cannot contact you by phone) and then send a follow up letter. If your child is well, they can continue to attend school as normal whilst you wait for the PCR test outcome.

Please can I ask that you do not send your child to school if they have a high temperature, a cough and/or a loss of smell or taste. We are also aware that children with coronavirus can often have upset tummies and sickness. We have currently got a 48-hour rule for any cases of diarrhoea or sickness – please do not bring your child back to school for 48 hours after their last episode of vomiting or diarrhoea.

I am also aware that a number of parents have used lateral flow tests on their children, obtained a negative result, their child has subsequently developed more symptoms and then tested positive on a PCR. I would ask that any child or person in your household who displays symptoms arranges a PCR test as soon as symptoms appear.

If you are at all concerned please speak to either Mrs Woolley or myself on the gate in the morning or at the end of the day.
