The focus of the parents evening this term is on how your child/ren have settled into school life. For those of you who book a remote meeting, we will be providing you with an opportunity to look at your children's books later in term 2 or 3.

A dialogue sheet will also be sent out in advance of the parents evening and this provides you with an opportunity to inform the class teacher(s) about any concerns or questions you want to discuss. Please return this to the school office by Friday 30th September.

Christmas Shop

The Christmas shop is now open!! Order now to get your children's own design on cards, coasters, wrapping paper and more!

This year we're making it easier for parents to order and for the PTFA to process more quickly.

All orders must be placed online: <https://www.stbonsptfa.com/christmas-shop>

When ordering please put your ***child's name* in the delivery address** and make sure their class is correct at the checkout.

You have until next ***Wednesday (28th September)*** to place your orders online.

Then children will design their card in school and we will place the order. You won't see the design before you order but we know they will all be wonderful and it will be great fun seeing them when they arrive.

If you would like to see the design before ordering we are offering you the opportunity to produce your own Christmas card design at home. This will need to be returned to the PTFA and attached to your online order.

If you choose to do your own artwork at home you must:

- ✓ complete it within an 18x12cm **portrait** rectangle
- ✓ only use felt tips or coloured pencils (faint colours won't reproduce well) no glitter, glue, glitter pens or crayons
- ✓ it must be kept flat (no folds)



- ✓ be **handed directly to Sarah** (she will be in the reception line - hopefully wearing a Santa hat) at drop off on Wednesday 28th, Thursday 29th or Friday 30th September.
- ✓ it must be **labelled** with your child's name, class and your online order number (generated by the PTFA website when you order).

All children will still be creating artwork in school and all orders will be directly linked to those unless you hand correctly labelled artwork directly to Sarah. They must not go to the drop box, office or teacher.

No artwork will be by accepted after drop off on Friday 30th September.

We know this is a change and we understand it's different but the admin behind the Christmas cards was huge and unsustainable. We are trying to make it easier and simpler to order and organise. We considered lots of different options and this was the only feasible way while keeping the costs down.

We will review the process later in the academic year.
