Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome back to Term 3! I hope everyone has had a restful break and feels ready for a new year.

This term we are launching our new reward system for pupils who have 100% attendance (i.e. arrive at school on time and leave at the end of the school day) for the whole term. At the end of each term we will be awarding pupils with 100% attendance 5 house points. The number of house points for each class will be calculated and announced at praise assembly during the first week of the following term.

So, make sure bags are packed ready at the end of the day, early nights for everyone and set your alarm clocks 5 minutes early – let's see how many points pupils can accumulate!

<u>Is there anything we need to know about things at home to help your child at school?</u> The best way for your child to make the most of their school day is to feel happy and supported.

Please do let us know if there is anything happening at home which you would like us to be aware of. This enables us to help your child in school. Roast dinner - Tuesday 10th January


There will be a change of menu next Tuesday – the kitchen will be serving roast turkey instead of roast gammon which is listed on the Eden menu for week 3.


