
We are holding an Open Evening at St Bonaventure's pre-school.

This is a brief opportunity to visit the Pre School and have a look around the setting. You will have the opportunity to have an informal chat with members of staff and gain an overview of the pre-school.



One Off Payment – outstanding payments

Many thanks to all our parents who have paid for their child(ren)'s one off payment for this year. Whilst we do acknowledge that this payment is voluntary, we do need to make a particular appeal this year that everyone who is able to pay does so. Our budgets are extremely tight and we will be forced to cancel class trips if insufficient funds are collected.
