Dear parents and carers,

Thank you to everyone for your generous donations to the Go Green for CAFOD Harvest Appeal yesterday. We will let you know the amount raised next week. Thank you also to Liz Baldwin from CAFOD who came to speak to the children at the start of Mass. The wonderful Harvest Loaf was kindly donated by Joe's Bakery – thank you to them as well – it was amazing as always!



### COVID Update

We have seen an increase in the number of children and staff testing positive on lateral flow tests and subsequently negative on PCR tests. I received the following from Alison Hurley, Director of Education and Skills for Bristol yesterday:

“UK Health Security Agency (UKHSA) have been made aware of some areas reporting positive LFD test results with subsequent negative PCR tests and are currently looking into the cause. Whilst the UKHSA investigation is under-way, we advise that if a pupil or staff member has been in close contact with a positive case (such as a household member) or has displayed COVID-19 symptoms and has tested positive on an LFD (but subsequently tested negative on a PCR), they are treated as potentially infectious. We recommend they isolate and remain out of the setting, for 10 days.”

Parents should continue to keep us informed of any positive COVID test results. This allows us to monitor any emerging patterns across the school. You can help mitigate the spread of the virus by not attending school if suffering from symptoms of COVID-19 (high temperature, loss of taste or smell, continuous cough). Please can you, therefore, ensure that your child only returns to school when they well enough and are not displaying any signs of illness. Thank you for your ongoing support through this period.

### INSET days

I just want to remind you all that we have two inset days approaching: Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> October and Monday 1<sup>st</sup> November. We are able to provide a holiday club on Monday 1<sup>st</sup> November. Please sign up for this via the Gateway App.

### Parent focus group

The parent focus group held their first meeting of the academic year earlier this week. Thank you to everyone who was able to attend and contribute. The use of Google classroom was discussed and the school has some points to action in response.

## School meals – price increase from 1<sup>st</sup> November

We have been advised by our catering provider, Chartwells, that as of 1<sup>st</sup> November, the cost of a school lunch will increase from £2.25 to £2.30. This change will happen automatically when your child orders a lunch and will be reflected in their dinner money balance. Your balance can be viewed in the School Gateway app – it is only 'in debt' if there is a negative number given such as -£4.78. If it is an amount of £4.78, this is a credit balance.

## October half term Playscheme

Our Playscheme will be running this October half term, the week of 25<sup>th</sup> October. We will also be open for bookings on the second Inset day – Monday 1<sup>st</sup> November. The playscheme will not be open on the first Inset day, Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> October.

The cost of the club is £28 for a full day (8.30am until 6pm) and £21 for a short day (10am until 4pm). Bookings can now be made through School Gateway – visit the Clubs tab to make bookings.

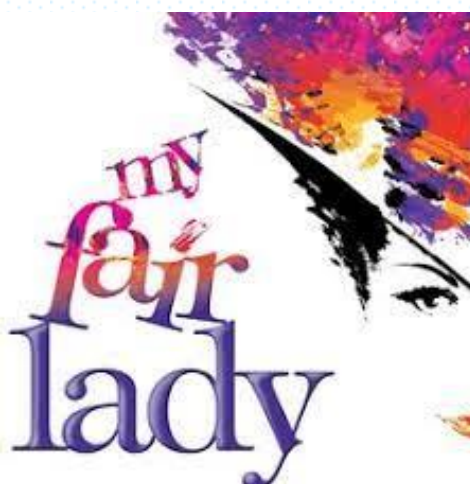
### My Fair Lady – production at St Bon's!
