Two free workshops at Kidzone Easter Playscheme

Kidzone are delighted to announce that two free workshops will be provided during the Easter Playscheme. These will take place on Weds 28th March and Thurs 5th April in the morning. The first session will be a Beatbox Workshop and the second a Making Music session. Here are some details for the sessions:

'Beatboxing is a form of vocal percussion that mimics drum sounds using the mouth and voice. It is the fastest growing 'instrument' in the world today and very accessible to all. The workshops will involve fun, interactive games to introduce techniques and rhythms to the group. The children will have the opportunity to create their own sounds and make music together as an acapella orchestra! The workshop will be led by Jack Salt, who is a playworker, teacher and musician.'

'Marcus Gee, a musician and play worker will facilitate this music workshop. Children will have the opportunity to play a variety of instruments. They will also be able to have a go at conducting the group, play at being the recording engineer and try out some basic recording techniques. The group will be able to create a piece of music and make a CD recording to keep! There'll also be some fun music games and arts and crafts activities.'

Kidzone offering free trial sessions for children with SEND

KidZone after school club has been providing after school care for St. Bonaventure's Primary School students for several years now, with sessions running Monday to Friday, between 15.15 and 18.00. The KidZone team offers a variety of activities including arts & crafts, team building games, cooking, sports, music, games and more, in different parts of the school's grounds (hall, outdoor playgrounds, library, music room, football pitch, arts room).

In an attempt to make our club more accessible to all and to welcome children who need some extra support, we would like to offer you a free trial on one of the upcoming Fridays (16th and 23rd March), between 15.15 and 17.00. It is important to remember that not all children who need 1:1 support in class will need it in the after school club, so during the session, we will assess your child's needs and discuss how we, in KidZone, can meet them best. You would need to attend the start of the session along with your child to ensure they feel calm and safe in the new environment and that staff have all the information they need.
