The st. Bonaventure's FUTURE LOTTERY

We are very lucky at St Bonaventure's to have such a fantastic new building and outside space for our children to thrive in. As many of you will know, we also have a very active PTFA which supports the school with many of our projects.

You may not be aware however that we also run the FUTURE LOTTERY every month (previously known as the 200 club) which anyone can join. For as little as £5 a month, you and your family can be in with a chance of winning monthly cash prizes whilst also contributing funds to our school. The top prize is a very generous £50!

The money raised from the Lottery has already contributed to the cost of Phase 4 of our new building (the administration block and the Hall) and was used to purchase the trees planted outside as well as the colourful markings on our playground.

We would now like to raise funds for our outside space to provide the best environment for our children. The diagrams sent out with this letter will show how the St Francis Garden and other parts of the playground will look once work is complete. We would also like to refurbish the Foundation Stage outside classroom.

School Library Reading Challenge

Today we launched our library reading challenge. We would like all children to use the library more and develop their love of reading. We have launched a challenge for all children to read as many books as possible between Monday 14th November 2016 and Monday 6th February 2017.

This is open to all year groups including Reception. To take part in the challenge, children need to borrow a book from the library (ensuring the book is logged out through our library computer system) and then complete a short book recommendation and post it in the box in the library. Reception parents please scribe for your child. Reception children will visit the library every Friday with their class teachers and can also visit during the after school sessions. Years 1 to 6 can visit the library during any of the times listed below.


