Celebrating Catholic Life at St. Bonaventure's!

This week at St. Bon's has been a celebration of our Catholic faith and the inspiring lives of saints.

We began the week with an ethos assembly focused on our school saints: St. Bonaventure, St. Francis, St. Claire, and St. Elizabeth. The children reflected on how these saints continue to inspire us in our daily lives. Our Year 6 Chaplaincy Team has been hard at work creating a prayer trail around the school, inviting everyone to learn more about these holy figures.

Today was our first ever "Adopt a Saint" day! Students and staff dressed as saints who inspire them, from the well-known like St. George, St Francis and St. Nicholas to the lesser-known like St Perpetua, St Bridget and St John Paul II. The children shared in class why they chose their particular saint and even pondered what their saint might think of the world today.

In our Love Thy Neighbour curriculum celebration assembly, each year group presented how their recent learning connected to the Gospel theme and Catholic Social Teaching principles. From the history of our school to the Bristol Bus Boycott, our students demonstrated a deep understanding of faith and social justice.

Our new Year 5 chaplains attended a training day with other Catholic schools in the Newman Partnership. They learned about the upcoming Jubilee Year and the theme of hope, participating in creative activities and making personal jubilee pledges. They were officially commissioned by Mgr.
